



BH&M have completed a large number of swimming pools across the country.

Ranging from small learner pools as at Glensk Preparatory School to the major eight lane international short course pool at Marlborough College, the Practice has an unparalleled expertise in this field. While swimming pools are often regarded as a simple building they are, in fact, technically one of the most difficult building types to handle, involving a high level of expertise in both construction and chemistry. Swimming pools require constant attention and the constant movement of large amounts of water in an environment that must be most carefully controlled.

BH&M have constructed swimming pools at **Charterhouse, Dulwich, Glensk, The Mall, Maltman's Green, Marlborough, Monmouth, New Hall, Telford and Wycombe Abbey** to name but a few.

Swimming Pools

Of these the most extensive and impressive is at Marlborough College. Constructed under the eagle eye of Edward Gould, Master of College and water polo player, this pool is 25 metres in length and has eight lanes. The polypropylene moving floor allows a variety of depths from zero to three metres, enabling full disabled access, shallow pool for learning, water polo and sub-aqua. The ability to provide a constant depth at two metres provides a national standard at water polo and the pool conforms with the ASA's requirements for national short course competition.

The pool, which includes an extensive public area to one side and changing rooms both for swimming and external use, was opened by Sharron Davies, MBE and Olympian in 2002.
